**"But I'm not Welsh"** – That's not a problem, many of our choristers aren't Welsh. Some join because they've got Welsh connections but others join just because they love that special harmony that is Welsh male voice singing.

**"I can't make such a big commitment"** – We only rehearse once a week and there's no 3-line whip to attend; it really isn't that onerous. You'll enjoy it so much you'll make time, and not everyone attends every concert.

**"I'm too shy to perform"** – You'll be amongst lots of friends so you can hide. And the audiences don't bite.

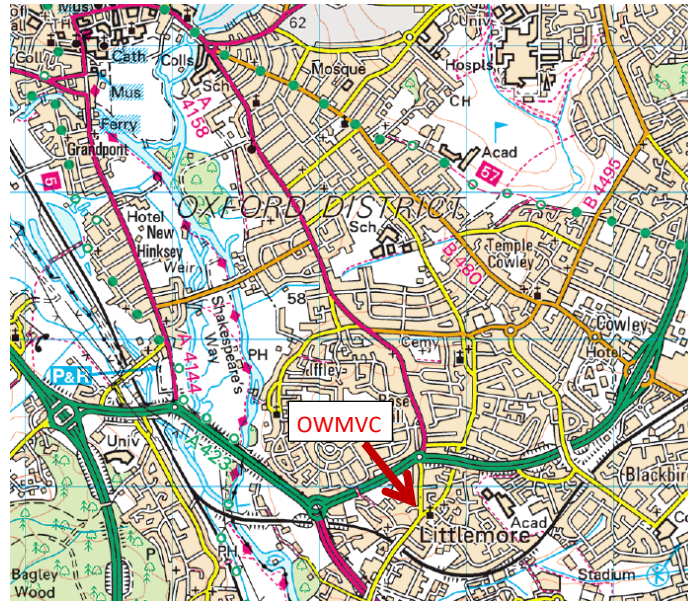

Further afield, we've sung in the Royal Albert Hall, Westminster Abbey, Greenwich Maritime Museum and even along the touch line of Cardiff's Millennium Stadium. We've also performed in France, Holland, Tenerife and the USA.

## Welsh Hymns and Romantic ballads, Opera to Folk, Sacred or Secular

Our range is wide and varied, and our concerts are a carefully balanced selection of pieces. Of course we always include traditional Welsh hymns and folk songs loved by generations but we also enjoy music from other genres and cultures. Whether it's classical pieces by the likes of Mozart or Verdi, songs from musicals such as Les Miserables or classics by Queen, Elvis Presley or Robbie Williams. Concert programmes are planned to suit, based on an ever-changing repertoire. Songs for weddings, funerals and special occasions will be discussed with the families. We're happy to recruit soloists to add variety and balance to our concerts and the choir is particularly keen to support young performers in the early stages of their careers.
